

# How To Make: MCM

## A Short Film In

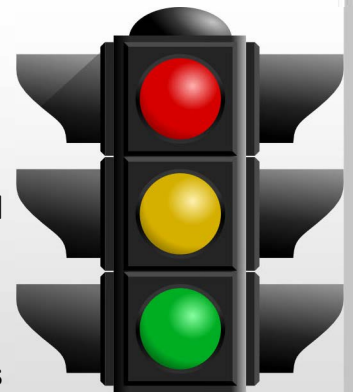
### 1. Write!

Have an idea? Make it into a script! Need help with an idea or script in progress? Bring it to the MCM Writer's Room, we can help! Or get peer review from friends, professors, colleagues, experienced writers, family members, animals, loved ones, etc. Any peer review is good review!



### 2. Greenlight!

Get your script green-lit! Send it to our email at [mcmfilmmakers@gmail.com](mailto:mcmfilmmakers@gmail.com). After being read by our Advisors, Officers, and Board Members it will be assigned a color. **Green** means it's good to go and then will be posted to our group MCM page for fellow members to read. Yellow means it needs a little work, either on formatting or story elements, and will be sent back for revisions. Red means for one reason or another it's not feasible for MCM, and we'll work together in fixing that!



### 3. Pitch!

Once green-lit, it's time to pitch! For this step, writers will need to create a logline (1-2 sentence summary of film). If you're a new member, we will assist in this process. Then at the following MCM meeting, those writers will then pitch their loglines to their fellow members.



### 4. Vote!

After all of our writers have pitched their scripts, we then move onto Vote! As a group, all of our members get to vote upon the scripts they'd like to see be made. We tally up the votes and come to a general consensus on the top ones. Ideally by this point our members will have already read the scripts that were greenlit and posted to our page! (This helps with the voting process)
